## EAA Schools and Webinars

### ▪ The 3<sup>rd</sup> EAA Budapest School and Clinical Andrologist examination



The third edition of the EAA Budapest School took place as a traditional 'face-to-face' meeting on 1-3 March 2022. The School was co-organised by Zsolt Kopa (EAA Training Centre in Budapest) and the EAA Office, with support from the EAA, ANDRONET and the Semmelweis University. Due to the continuing COVID-19-related restrictions, the programme was limited to basic andrology for clinicians. The faculty was composed of the members of the EAA Executive Council with two major experts in sexual medicine, Cobi Reisman and Giovanni Corona. After the course, the examination for the certificate of EAA Clinical Andrologist was held (*see below*).

### ▪ The EAA Ultrasound School

The main objective of this School is to provide a high-quality level training in andrological ultrasound, and to standardize the methodology of male genital tract and penile ultrasound in Europe. The School's Coordinators are Francesco Lotti (University of Florence) and Andrea M. Isidori (Sapienza University of Rome), and additional faculty includes experienced imaging specialists from both centres. The 6<sup>th</sup> edition of this popular hands-on EAA School started in April 2022, and six fellows have been enrolled. ### ▪ Zagreb Summer School and the 4<sup>th</sup> Andrology Symposium

The 3<sup>rd</sup> edition of the EAA School in Testis Histology and Pathology was held on 27 June- 1 July 2022, in Zagreb, Croatia. The School was co-organised by the EAA training centres in Zagreb and Copenhagen, and was supported by the EAA and ANDRONET. The School included a lot of hands-on practicals, including training in TESE, ICSI, processing of the

testicular biopsy and real-time microscopy. The programme was enriched by microsurgery videos of sperm retrieval techniques presented by Zsolt Kopa (Hungary). The attendees came from 12 countries, including as remote as Indonesia and USA. The School was followed by the 4<sup>th</sup> Andrology Symposium, organized by the Centre of Excellence for Reproductive and Regenerative Medicine, School of Medicine University of Zagreb and Croatian Society for Andrology. The faculty included international experts; E. Ruiz-Castañe, A. Calogero, C. Easley, D. Fietz, R. Middendorf, R. Oliva and S. Schlatt.


## Other EAA-endorsed educational events

- **International Meeting “The Future of ART”, incl. Workshop “The Andrologist in the IVF Center”**

- **European Congress of Endocrinology 2022**

According to the agreement with the European Society of Endocrinology (ESE), the EAA organised the **Pre-Congress Course in Clinical Andrology for Endocrinologists** on 21 May 2022, during the ECA-2022 in Milan, Italy. The Faculty included five EAA Academicians: Leen Antonio, Marco Bonomi, Dimitrios Goulis, Csilla Krausz and Giovanni Corona (*pictured on the right*).



- **3rd International Congress on Male Contraception**

The meeting was organised by the International Consortium for Male Contraception and took place on 23 May 2022 in Paris, France. The EAA was represented by Csilla Krausz, who presented a lecture on male contraception candidates identified by genetic studies.

- **Congress of the European Association of Urology (EAU)**

During the EAU Congress (held 1-4 July, Amsterdam, The Netherlands), a joint session of the EAA and the EAU Section on Andrological Urology (ESAU) was held on: “Male reproductive health is a guard for general health in the man”. The session was moderated by N. Sofikitis and C. Krausz, and the speakers included A. Giwercman, S. Minhas, T. Diemer, C. Krausz and F. Dimitriadis. In addition, several EAA members lectured at other andrology-related sessions (e.g. on hypogonadism), including L. Antonio, G. Corona, Z. Kopa, M. Maggi, S. Minhas, M. Zitzmann.
